NOTICE OF DISPUTED IDENTITY CHARACTERIZATION, REQUEST FOR CORRECTION AND CLARIFICATION OF PUBLIC DOCKET INFORMATION, AND SUPPLEMENTAL RECORD

I. PURPOSE OF NOTICE

This Notice is submitted to preserve and clarify the record concerning the identities and capacities of the parties appearing in this matter and certain characterizations that have become associated with the litigation through publicly accessible docket information and third-party republication.

This Notice does not request alteration of authentic judicial filings or historical docket entries. It requests that inaccurate or incomplete party information, captions, metadata, and identity characterizations be corrected or clarified to the extent permitted by the Federal Rules, the Court's docketing procedures, and applicable law.

II. CORRECT IDENTIFICATION OF PARTIES AND CAPACITIES

The originating complaint, removal papers, and other controlling filings should be reproduced and cited exactly as filed. The filing should identify each petitioner, trust, estate, or other party in the capacity actually asserted in the originating record.

The original initiating document should be attached as Exhibit A so that the Court can compare the original caption and party designations against later docket metadata and third-party reproductions.

III. LEGAL NAME RECORD

A Nevada District Court entered an Order for Change of Name in Case No. D-21-624033-N. That order should be attached as documentary evidence concerning the legal name Prince Ra Hotep El.

The Nevada order is submitted solely as documentary evidence concerning the legal name Prince Ra Hotep El and not as an assertion that the name-change proceeding adjudicated the merits of this federal litigation.

IV. DISPUTED "SOVEREIGN CITIZEN" CHARACTERIZATION

Prince Ra Hotep El expressly disputes and rejects characterization of him as a "sovereign citizen."

To the extent that this terminology appears in any filing, order, docket metadata, party description, electronic database, or material derived from this proceeding, the filer requests that the record clearly distinguish between a party's allegation or characterization and an adjudicated finding of the Court.

Prince Ra Hotep El does not identify himself by the characterization "sovereign citizen," and requests that the term not be presented as an established biographical or legal fact concerning his identity.

V. THIRD-PARTY REPUBLICATION

The federal docket has been reproduced by third-party legal-information and data-aggregation services. Inaccurate or incomplete source information can consequently propagate into search engines, people-search databases, legal-research databases, and automated summaries.

This Notice is therefore submitted both to preserve the federal record and to provide an authoritative reference that may be supplied to third parties receiving or republishing docket information.

The supplied Justia reproduction expressly states that its docket and filing materials are public litigation records and should not be considered findings of fact or liability, nor do they necessarily reflect Justia's view.

VI. CAPTION, ESTATE TRUST, AND PARTY RECORD

The filing should compare the following records side by side:

- A. The caption and parties actually submitted in the originating federal filing; and
- B. The caption and party information presently appearing in PACER/ECF and derivative docket services.

Where those records materially differ, Petitioners request correction or clarification sufficient to preserve the existence and asserted capacity of Monica Rene Hall Estate Trust and the identities and capacities of the other parties appearing in the originating record.

No inference concerning intent or motive is requested merely from a discrepancy. The purpose of the comparison is to establish an accurate documentary record.

VII. DISCREPANCIES AMONG OFFICIAL AND THIRD-PARTY DOCKET REPRODUCTIONS

The record presently available from different docket-republication services may not cover the same time period. For example, the supplied Justia reproduction states that the docket was last retrieved on July 28, 2022 and that a more recent docket listing may be available from PACER.

Accordingly, Petitioners request identification of the authoritative current PACER/ECF record and reconciliation of material discrepancies among the official record and third-party reproductions, including:

- the latest docket entry displayed;
- the date each service last retrieved or synchronized the docket;
- the caption displayed;
- parties displayed or omitted;
- whether Monica Rene Hall Estate Trust is identified;
- the designation used for Prince Ra Hotep El; and
- any disputed identity characterization.

The purpose of this comparison is to determine provenance and synchronization of the public record rather than to presume that any discrepancy was intentionally caused.

VIII. RESERVED DETERMINATION CONCERNING ADDITIONAL PERSONS

Any determination concerning whether Richard Ehlers or any other person should be excluded from the notice, treated as a witness or record participant, or identified as a person whose conduct or communications require examination is reserved pending documentary review.

No allegation of behind-the-scenes participation, alteration, or improper motive is asserted as an established fact in this Notice absent supporting evidence.

IX. NO REQUEST TO ERASE HISTORICAL RECORD

Petitioners do not request destruction or concealment of authentic judicial records. They request preservation of an accurate record identifying which statements constitute allegations, which constitute judicial findings, which names and capacities were actually pleaded, and which subsequent descriptions originated from third parties.

X. REQUESTED RELIEF

1. Accept this Notice and its exhibits into the record;
2. Review the official caption and party metadata against the originating pleadings;
3. Correct clerical inaccuracies or incomplete party information where authorized;
4. Clarify that disputed identity characterizations should not be represented as adjudicated findings unless an order actually made such a finding;
5. Preserve Monica Rene Hall Estate Trust's appearance in the historical record in the capacity actually reflected by the filed pleadings;
6. Correct or annotate docket metadata where necessary to accurately identify Prince Ra Hotep El;
7. Preserve the submitted Nevada name-change order as supporting identity documentation;
8. Identify the authoritative caption and party record and identify post-August 2022 docket events relevant to the discrepancy analysis;
9. Where feasible, identify or explain material discrepancies between originating pleadings, current ECF/PACER metadata, and information transmitted to public docket-republication services; and
10. Grant such other record-correction relief as the Court considers appropriate.

XII. CORE RECORD-CORRECTION REQUEST

Identify the authoritative caption and party record, identify every relevant post-August 2022 docket event, and correct or explain any material discrepancy between the originating pleadings, current ECF/

PACER metadata, and information transmitted to public docket-republication services.

CLARIFICATION OF Prince Ra Hotep El's CAPACITY

The historical record must distinguish between the named Petitioners in the underlying proceeding and Prince Ra Hotep El's separately stated capacity or appearance. Only as the Executor and nothing else filing records foreign judgments and court records.

The August 2022 *Void Ab Initio Notice / Color of Law Defacto* displayed in Exhibit I identifies **Princess Emilily Hotep El** in the Petitioner(s) portion of the document and identifies **Ally Bank, et al.** in the Respondent(s) portion, with Aldridge Pite Haan LLP separately identified. **Prince Ra Hotep El is not identified as a Petitioner in that displayed caption.**

Consistent with that distinction, the reproduced federal docket identifies Filing 3 as a **“NOTICE of Special Appearance by Prince Ra Hotep El, Monica Rene Hall Estate Trust.”**

Accordingly, the record should not transform a special appearance, representative capacity, trustee/executor capacity, or other separately identified participation into an assertion that Prince Ra Hotep El was personally the Petitioner wherever the originating record does not say so.

The phrase "sovereign citizen" does not appear in the text of the supplied eight-page Justia docket record. Accordingly, this exhibit does not attribute that characterization to Justia without a separate source showing that Justia published it.

Purpose. This exhibit documents a separate Indiana criminal appellate record involving an individual named Yusuf Hotep-El and preserves the distinction between that individual and Prince Ra Hotep El. It is intended to support requests that search engines, data aggregators, legal publishers, and automated systems avoid conflating persons merely because their names contain the words “Hotep” and “El.”

A. INDIANA LAWYER PUBLICATION

The Indiana Lawyer published an article on November 13, 2018 concerning Yusuf Hotep-El and an Indiana Court of Appeals decision. The publication’s headline refers to a “sovereign citizen.” The article identifies the subject as Yusuf Hotep-El and discusses criminal charges arising in Indiana, including possession of cocaine, possession of narcotic drugs, possession of a controlled substance, possession of marijuana, and an habitual-offender allegation.

B. OFFICIAL INDIANA APPELLATE RECORD

The corresponding Indiana Court of Appeals matter is Yusuf Hotep-El v. State of Indiana, Court of Appeals Case No. 18A-CR-477, decided November 13, 2018. The official opinion identifies Yusuf Hotep-El as the Appellant-Defendant and describes the criminal charges and the dispute concerning termination of his self-representation.

Where a search engine, data broker, legal publisher, knowledge panel, automated summary, or other database associates Prince Ra Hotep El with the Indiana criminal matter involving Yusuf Hotep-El, the publisher is requested to identify the source and matching methodology responsible for that association and to correct, suppress, de-index, or otherwise disambiguate any unsupported identity linkage to the extent available under its policies and applicable law.

Under [28 U.S.C. § 1331](#), federal district courts have jurisdiction over "all civil actions arising under the Constitution, laws, or treaties of the United States." Ally's complaint alleges only state law claims, so there is no federal question jurisdiction. See ECF No. 16 at 16-20. Hotep El's federal defenses or counterclaims cannot create federal question jurisdiction for removal. See [Holmes Grp., Inc. v. Vornado Air Circulation Sys., Inc., 535 U.S. 826, 831 \(2002\)](#) (stating that a counterclaim cannot serve as the basis for federal question jurisdiction); [Hall v. N. Am. Van Lines, Inc., 476 F.3d 683, 687 \(9th Cir. 2007\)](#) (stating that "the existence of a defense based upon federal law is insufficient to support jurisdiction" (quotation omitted)).

There is no diversity jurisdiction to support removal in this case either. Under [28 U.S.C. § 1332\(a\)\(1\)](#), federal district courts have original jurisdiction over civil actions in diversity cases "where the matter in controversy exceeds the sum or value of \$75,000" and where the matter is between "citizens of different States." Ally seeks far below the jurisdictional amount in controversy in the underlying action. See ECF No. 16 at 16-20. Again, Hotep El cannot rely on the amount she seeks on any counterclaims to support removal.

As the party seeking to invoke this court's jurisdiction, Hotep El bears the burden of proving this court has jurisdiction. [Corral v. Select Portfolio Servicing, Inc., 878 F.3d 770, 773 \(9th Cir. 2017\)](#). Hotep El has not done so. I therefore remand this action to the state court from which it was removed.

Because I remand the case, I deny all pending motions as moot.

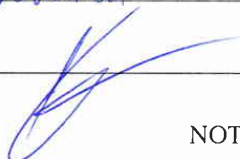

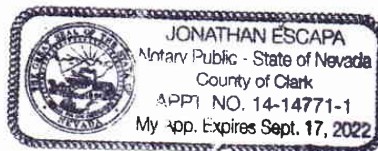

We are writing on behalf of the House of Judah Estate Trust concerning an unauthorized and fraudulent electronic lien/title record allegedly processed through PDP Group systems under the name of Ally Bank.

I. Violation of Title Law and False Filing

A fabricated electronic title record dated July 12, 2021, has surfaced, showing a lien recorded via your platform or third-party electronic lien system. This document was never disclosed to the Estate Trust, never agreed upon, and post-dates a UCC-1 Financing Statement filed by the Trust on May 19, 2021. Said lien is recorded under #20210519606-2.

Furthermore, the vehicle in question has never been registered in the State of Tennessee, and the contract with the Nevada DMV was lawfully voided. The estate perfected its interest and filed a foreign judgment as of April 15, 2022—well before this unauthorized title was manufactured.

Consumer Alert: Real Estate Identity Theft and Fraud on the Rise

What property owners, homebuyers and industry professionals need to know to avoid becoming a victim

CARSON CITY, NV – The Nevada Division of Insurance and the Nevada Real Estate Division want to bring public awareness and education to an increasingly prevalent real estate identity theft scam. Known as “vacant lot fraud” or “seller impersonation fraud,” bad actors impersonate the owners of a property or vacant lot and attempt to sell it for their own profit.

Unsuspecting owners, eager buyers and even licensed real estate and insurance professionals guiding the transactions can all unknowingly end up as victims in these elaborate identity theft schemes. The best way to protect yourself from this rising threat is to understand how the scam works, know the red flags to look out for, and the precautions you can take to prevent this scam from happening to you or your clients.

How the scam works

Scammers search public records to identify owners of real estate that is free of a mortgage or other liens, most often targeting vacant lots and investment, vacation or rental properties that are non-owner occupied. The scammer then poses as the owner and contacts a real estate agent to list the property for sale. Once an offer is made, the scammer quickly accepts it, then sends falsified documents to the title firm or closing attorney. The closing proceeds are then transferred to the scammer leaving the fraud typically undiscovered until transferring documents are recorded with the applicable county.

Watch out for red flags

According to the American Land Title Association (ALTA), homebuyers and licensed professionals alike should consider conducting additional due diligence or halt a transaction if they see these potentially suspicious seller behaviors:

- Seller is difficult to reach via phone or refuses to meet via video call; only communicates via

text or email

- Seller sets listing price lower than the current market value and wants a fast cash sale with little or no fee negotiation
- Seller refuses to attend signings; always claiming to be out of town
- Seller requests to use their own notary
- Seller demands proceeds be wired
- Seller has a different address than the owner's address or tax mailing address
- Seller refuses or is unable to complete multifactor authentication of identity verification

Precautions you can take

ALTA advises title and real estate professionals to take the following precautions during the transaction to help thwart scammer's attempts early on:

- Contact the seller directly at an independently discovered and validated phone number
- Send mail to the seller at the address listed on tax and property records
- Ask the seller's real estate agent if they have personal or verified knowledge of the seller's identity
- If using a remote notary, be sure the notary is fully vetted and approved by your state; otherwise, the title company should arrange for an in-person notary signing at an attorney's office, title agency, or bank.
- Verify the seller's identity by sending the seller a link to complete a third-party identity verification
- Run the seller's email and phone number through a verification program
- Ask conversational questions to ascertain seller's knowledge of property information not readily available in public records
- Compare the seller's signature to previously recorded public documents
- Use a wire verification service or confirm wire instructions match account details on seller's disbursement authorization form
- Require a copy of a voided check with a disbursement authorization form
- Require that a check be sent for seller proceeds rather than a wire

Additionally, property monitoring services are offered by most county recorder's offices to help alert owners to any activity or attempted transactions involving their property. Prospective buyers can also purchase the American Land Title Association Homeowner's Policy of Title Insurance for additional fraud protection. If you are ever in doubt, have questions, or

something does not feel right during a real estate transaction, always speak directly with your real estate agent/broker or your title insurance agent.
